Finding Full Text Online Self Test (Answer Key) *February 2008*

1. Find the user name and password for the online book *ACP Medicine*.

Type *ACP Medicine* in to the search box on the Library homepage and click on Journal Titles, and then on Search. Click on Passworded Journals to get the username and password. (Username: denison Password: search), then click on the link that says "Go to the journal at the publisher's Web site." to go to the publication's webpage.

2. Does the library have access to "The use of relaxation, hypnosis, and imagery in sport psychiatry", by TS Newmark in *Clinics in Sports Medicine*, Oct 2005; 24(4): 973-7?

Type *Clinics in Sports Medicine* in to the search box on the Library homepage and click on Journal Titles, and then on Search. Click on the link for "MD Consult Core Clinics", then type *Newmark* in the author last name box, then click on Search button. Click the "PDF" link in the right hand window under the citation for the article to open the full text. (Use the Adobe Toolbar buttons to save and print)

3. Can you access the Adobe Acrobat Reader PDF format full text for "Nurses as Knowledge Workers" by Tim Porter-O'Grady in *Creative Nursing*, 2003, 9 (2): 6?

Type *Creative Nursing* in the search box on the Library homepage, click on Journal Titles, then click on SEARCH. Click on the link for "Academic Search Premier", click on the "Search within this publication" link, then type *knowledge workers* into the second search box and click on "Search". Click on the "PDF Full Text" link (Use the Adobe Toolbar buttons to save and print)

OR click on the 2003, then issue 2, then find the article in the list. Click on the "PDF Full Text" link (Use the Adobe Toolbar buttons to save and print)

4. Can you find the full text of the article by Schalock PC, & Zug KA titled "Bacitracin" in *Cutis* published in August 2005, 76(2):105-7?

Type *Cutis* in the search box on the Library homepage, click on Journal Titles, then click on SEARCH. The record indicates that we have "from 1965 to 2005 in **Print Journals** - Health Sciences Library, University of Colorado Denver". This means that we have no online full text, and users must come to the library to photocopy the article, or scan it into PDF.

5. Is full text available for "Abrupt outpatient withdrawal of medication in analgesic-abusing migraineurs" by R Hering and TJ Steiner, in *Lancet*, June 15, 1991;337(8755):1442-3?

If you use the PubMed Single Citation Matcher, click on the "Article Linker" button. Notice that ScienceDirect offers full text from 1823 to present. You will be linked to an abstract on the Science Direct website when you click on "Article" and you can click on the PDF link to view or save the PDF.

6. Is the article "Efficacy of a Behavioral Intervention for Increasing Safer Sex Behaviors in HIV-Negative, Heterosexual Methamphetamine Users: Results From the Fast-Lane Study", by Mausbach, Brent T.; Semple, Shirley J.; Strathdee, Steffanie A.; Zians, Jim; Patterson, Thomas L. in *Annals of Behavioral Medicine*, 2007, 34 (3), p263-274 available online?

No, if you search for this journal in the **Find Journals**, note the holdings statement "from 02/01/2001 to 1 year ago". There is an "embargo". This means our subscription does not include the most recent 12 months.

7. Find the full text for *Environ Toxicol Pharmacol*

You can search using the MEDLINE abbreviation of a journal title in **Find Journals** (<http://hsclibrary.uchsc.edu/journals>). Careful though, some journals aren't indexed by their abbreviation, so if you don't find an abbreviated title, then try again using the full title (in this case *Environmental Toxicology and Pharmacology*).
